SG05-10 is a fiberglass fabric impregnated with PTFE (polytetraflouroethylene) dispersion and coated with high-temperature, pressure-sensitive silicone adhesive **Application Information**

SG05-10 is frequently used by the packaging industry as a release surface on heat sealers, blister formation and form-fill-seal equipment. The durability and anti-stick properties of SG05-10 make it an ideal material for the lining of guide rails, chutes, and slides. The high temperature capabilities and non-stick properties of SG05-10 allow it to perform as an excellent release surface in the composite aircraft industry.
