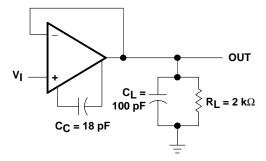


Figure 1. Unity-Gain Amplifier

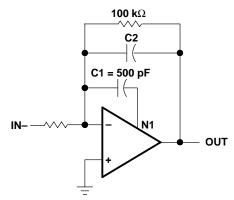


Figure 3. Feed-Forward Compensation

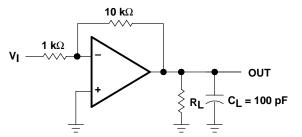


Figure 2. Gain-of-10 Inverting Amplifier

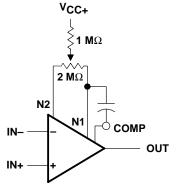


Figure 4. Input Offset Voltage Null Circuit
