

Following the release of Quartus Prime 20.1 on April 13, 2020, support for ARM DS-5 will be dropped from Quartus Prime Pro and Standard.

The following development kits include an ARM DS-5 license serial number – these will become invalid after Quartus Prime 20.1 release.

Customers will have to purchase **ESW-DS-FIX** separately to receive an ARM DS license serial number, which will be the replacement product for ARM DS-5.

Customers who have purchased any of the above development kits before April 13, 2020 will continue to have access to ARM DS-5 with Quartus 19.4 and previous releases, with support for up to 1-year under the terms of ARM's license agreement.

There will be a hold on new orders for the development kits listed above after April 13, 2020. The hold will last until the existing stock has been updated to remove ARM DS-5. All inventory with distributors must be recalled back to Intel so these changes can be accommodated.
