E-T-A's mission is to protect lives and assets. Starting with overcurrent protection, this is the purpose of our products and systems. As a family-owned company, we've decided to focus our activities on markets and applications that align with our mission and are consistent with our values. As a result, we have decided to exit the military market, in particular all combat applications, by May 2023.

Below is the defined timeline detailing important dates of our exit strategy.

- Last Order: September 2022
- Last Delivery: May 2023

We understand this may present certain challenges given the nature of specific applications and apologize for any inconvenience this decision may result in. Your support team and sales channel at E-T-A remains committed to working with you between now and the approaching LTB date of September 30, 2022.
