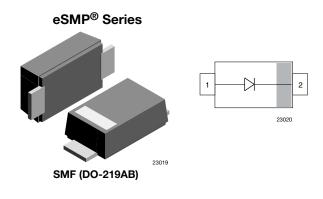

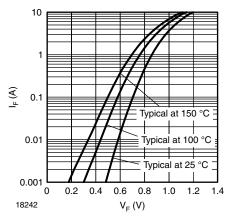


Fig. 1 - Typical Forward Characteristics

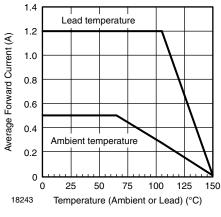


Fig. 2 - Forward Current Derating Curve

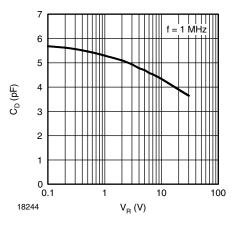


Fig. 3 - Typical Diode Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage

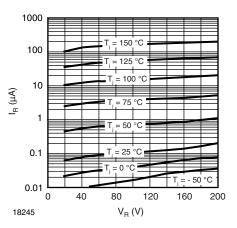


Fig. 4 - Typical Reverse Characteristics
