- Suitable for High Reliability and Automotive Requirement






Figure 1. Lead Temperature Measurement Conditions




Figure 2. $I_{F(AV)}$ vs. $T_L (T_J = 150 \text{ °C}, V_R = 0 \text{ V})$




Figure 3. $I_{F(AV)}$ vs. T_L ($T_J = 150 \ ^\circ C$, $V_R = 40 \ V$)




Figure 4. $P_{F(MAX)}$ vs. $I_{F(AV)}$ (T_J = 150 °C)




Figure 6. Typical Characteristics: I_F vs. V_F




Figure 5. $P_{R(MAX)}$ vs. V_R ($T_J = 150 \ ^{\circ}C$)




Figure 7. Typical Characteristics: I_R vs. V_R






Figure 8. Typical Transient Thermal Resistance Characteristics



Reflow:

Preheat: 150 °C to 200 °C / 60 s to 120 s Solder heating: 255 °C / 30 s, 3 times (260 °C peak) Soldering Iron: 350 °C / 3.5 s, 1 time


• SJP Land Pattern Example
